## Beginning May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021

- "all kids, every day" is our goal
- Students who are currently in our hybrid and attending school 2 days a week will begin attending 5 days a week
- Parents who were not yet ready to return their students in person submitted their request with the District Office

#### Rationale

- The majority of our families opted to phase in as guidance allowed back at the start of the 2020-2021 school year
- The guidelines for spacing of masked students in a classroom has been reduced to 3 feet, allowing for more students in each room and removing the need for the A/B cohorts
- Student engagement is higher during on-campus days

#### Instruction



- Instruction will begin to resemble more of what it once was. That is not to say that we haven't learned how to better implement technology in respect to increasing differentiation, student productivity, and engagement. We believe Forest Hill teachers and students have gained many skills from 13 months of distance teaching and learning.
- Teachers have been encouraged to minimize technology use while in person to decrease screen time, but it will depend on the grade level and activities teachers plan.
- Teachers will also communicate if they need students to continue to bring their Chromebooks back and forth or return them.





## Recess: Play Zones will continue




#### Recess

- 3 staggered recess blocks
- Students are assigned to a play zone with their classroom
- Zone rotations change weekly
- All classrooms have their own PE equipment and are color coordinated

#### Lunch

- 4 staggered lunch periods
- Students will be assigned a spot to eat 6 feet apart in their designated table groups



#### Lunch

- Lunches are available free to all students
- Students may bring a lunch from home or eat a school provided lunch.
- On Wednesdays, (early dismissal), students may take a "Grab and Go" lunch
- To reduce close contact and exposure, please send snacks and lunches that your student can open on his/her own.

## Baby Wipes



 Before students leave, they are asked to wipe down their learning space (desktop and chair)

 The purpose of this task is not to disinfect, but to remove dirt and grime from the used surface. This will make deeper cleaning more productive and efficient

### Hand Sanitizer



- Hand sanitizer bottles are available in every classroom
- Hand sanitizer stations are available on the playground during recess and lunch
- Students will be expected to sanitize/wash their hands as they arrive, before going out to recess/lunch and after coming back in.

### Supplies

- Water bottles- water fountains are closed
- Backpack
- Chromebook (<u>fully</u> charged each day)
- Mask
- Layers (doors and windows are open)
