Student Day at a Glance

Before School

- Complete the "COVID 19 Symptom Check" in the morning before going to school
- Come with a water bottle, a snack you can easily open, your charged Chromebook and headphones (only for CUSD devices and if teacher requests it)
- Wear your mask and layered clothing
- Arrive at your scheduled time and report to your assigned gate entrance
- If you are being dropped off by car, have your backpack ready, and please remain in your car until you are signaled to exit and walk to your gate
- □ K-1 students can have <u>only</u> 1 designated adult walk you to the gate
- Line up outside the gate
- □ If needed, students will be supported in getting to their classroom



- □ You will have an assigned seat in your classroom
- As you enter and exit class you will wash your hands or use hand sanitizer
- You will be asked to wipe your desk and chair with a baby wipe in order to help prepare your space for later disinfecting
- □ You will have individual school supplies and materials

At the End of the School Day

You will leave the school using the same gate as you arrived

You can pick up a free "Grab and Go" lunch at the gate when you exit

Students will line-up just outside their assigned gates
 Gate #2 (front) Unsinger, Ishimatsu, Faso, & LaValle
 Gate #3 (side) Hannan & Cittadino

The teacher will meet them at the gate and walk them to their classroom, because no visitors are permitted on campus

Students are to be picked up at the same gate at 11:40 AM for General Ed and 12:20 for Special Day Classes

- Only 4th and 5th grade students can bring their bikes to school

Students who arrive late need to report to the front office for a tardy slip.

Before Phase II

Parents complete the following before returning:

- □ Make sure your child has well fitted masks
- View the mask wearing and hand washing <u>videos</u>
- Practice wearing masks for longer periods of time to help build tolerance
- Show your child which gate they will use <u>prior</u> to the first day.
- Discuss with your child where you will meet them after school outside of the gates
- Remind your children that importance of attendance and being on time
- Read the <u>ready to return eBook</u> with your child
